Simple past is used to talk about a completed action in a time before now.

RULES

1. A) For the past simple of **regular verbs**, add “**ed**” to the verb.

For example: walk → walked

B) If the verb already ends in “-e”, only add “**d**” to the verb.

For example: like → liked

C) If the verb ends in a **consonant + -y**, change the “y” to “i”.

For example: carry → carried



2. Many verbs in English are **irregular**.

That means we do not add -ed/-d to form the past simple.

For **irregular verbs**, we change the verb using its simple past form.

RELATED TIME MARKERS

Time markers help us to understand **WHEN** things happened.

- Today (hoy)
- This morning (esta mañana)
- Yesterday (ayer)
- Last week (la semana pasada)
- Last month (el mes pasado)
- Last year (el año pasado)

SIMPLE PAST STRUCTURE



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Subject	Verb in past simple	Rest of the sentence
I	walked	in the street
You	visited	Talcahuano
He	loved	to play videogames
She	hated	cumbia music
It	exploded	yesterday
We	went	to school last week
They	sang	a song
